

# **Application Process**

#### 1. Application

On completion of this *Application for Admission Form*, return it and other required documentation to:

Cranbrook School Director of Admissions 5 Victoria Road Bellevue Hill NSW 2023

or you can scan and email it to enrol@cranbrook.nsw.edu.au.

All applications must include the non-refundable application fee of \$300. Please see Part G Payment Form for information as to how to make this payment.

You will receive a letter confirming receipt of your application.

#### 2. Assessment and Interview

Assessments and interviews may be held up to 12 months before the date of entry for Pre-school and Kindergarten and up to two years and six months before the date of entry for Year 3 and Year 7.

Some applicants may miss out on assessments and interviews due to demand for places exceeding places available.

The assessment involves your child participating in activities under the observation of staff. Interviews are held subsequent to the assessment and your child and both parents should attend.

#### 3. Review of Application

Your application will then be reviewed and an enrolment decision made. You will be notified in writing if an offer of enrolment is to be made or if your application was unsuccessful.

#### 4. Acceptance

If you receive an offer of enrolment, you must complete and return the required documentation and pay the enrolment fee within the timeframe specified in the letter of offer to confirm your child's place at Cranbrook School.
