Codicil Form

It is relatively straightforward to include a gift in your existing Will to the Cranbrook Foundation. To do so, you may wish to complete the Codicil Form below.

You will need to have your signature on the completed Codicil Form witnessed by two people at the same time and all three of you must use the same pen.

The two witnesses should NOT be members of your family or related to you in any way. They also should not be persons mentioned in your Will, such as a beneficiary or executor.

Once completed and signed, provide the original signed Codicil to the person who currently has your Will and ask them to retain it with your Will. If you have retained your Will, include the signed Codicil in the same envelope as your Will.

We recommend you seek professional advice from a legal advisor to ensure your wishes are recorded in a legally binding manner and that this Codicil Form is appropriate for your circumstances.
