ABOUT THE POSITION

Reporting to the Head of Athletic Performance, the responsibilities of the Strength and Conditioning Coach include developing and providing age and skill appropriate strength, conditioning, speed and agility training to students; designing and managing programs for rehabilitation and return to play from injury and illness; providing match day support to teams, supporting sports camps, holiday programs and tours; supervision of school gym facilities and use; taking part in health promotion and wellbeing initiatives for both students and staff; and assisting with sports science including data collection and analysis.

This is a full-time, permanent position, with rostered hours varying across the opening hours of the Aquatic & Fitness Centre, from Monday to Saturday.

You have experience working with youth athletes, and working in a gym, field and match day environment. You have the ability to inspire students to achieve goals and to encourage them in the pursuit of excellence.
