We hope you enjoy today's Carnival.

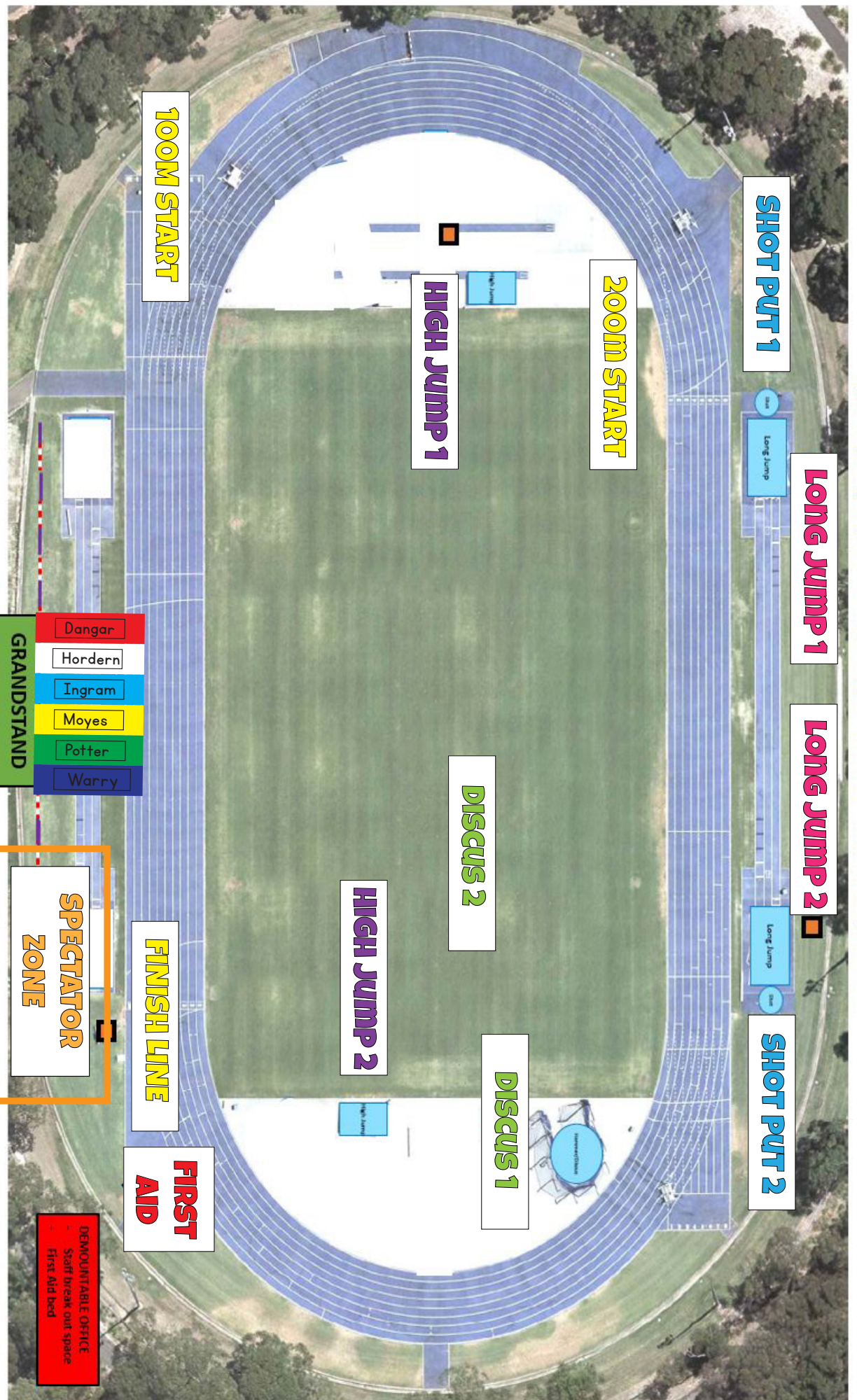
